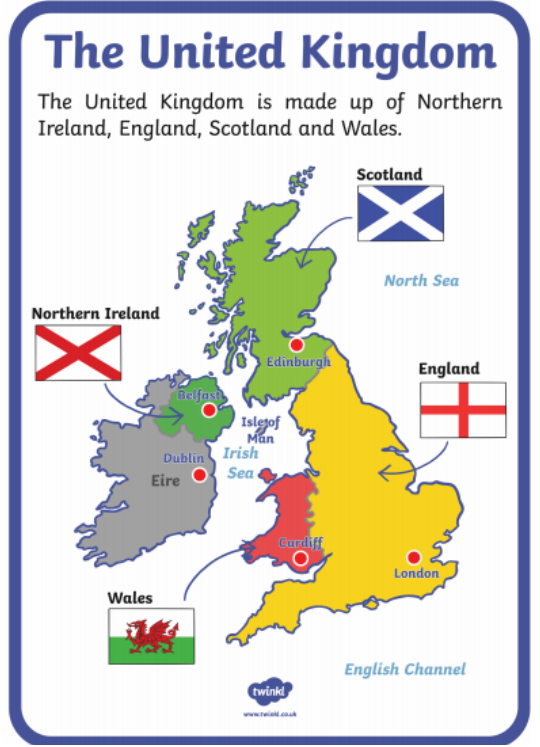

Physical Features	E.g. beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, season, weather

Continents	Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe, Australia
Oceans	Pacific Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Arctic Ocean, Indian Ocean, Southern Ocean
The United Kingdom	England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland
Capital Cities (U.K.)	London, Edinburgh, Cardiff, Belfast
The Equator	An imaginary line that divides the world into the Northern and Southern Hemisphere.
Landmarks	Human or Physical features which make a place significant e.g. The London Eye or the Angel of the North.
Map, globe, atlas	A representation of an area of land or sea. We can use them to find and identify places around the world.
