Who was Grace Darling?



Grace Darling was born on 24th November 1815. Her father was a lighthouse keeper.

What did Grace Darling do?

On 7th September 1838, a boat called *Forfarshire* became trapped in a storm and struck a rock.

Grace and her father spotted the shipwreck and some survivors.

Then they got in a rowing boat and fought through the rough sea to rescue the survivors.

Why is Grace Darling significant?

During the **Victorian Period**, most women were expected to stay at home.

The rowing boat was made for 3 strong men and Grace was only 22 years old.

Grace became a **national** hero for saving lives and even won an award for her bravery.

Where did Grace Darling live?



Grace Darling was born in Bamburgh, Northumberland.

When she was 10 years old, Grace and her family moved to Longstone Lighthouse in the Farne Islands.

lighthouse	A tower near the coast with a powerful, bright light to warn ships of danger.
portrait	A painting or photograph of somebody's face.
local	Something that is close to where you live.
sources	Something that tells us about history and was made at the time such as a letter, object, diaries and newspapers.
interpretations	What people believe happened. Not everyone will believe the same thing.
